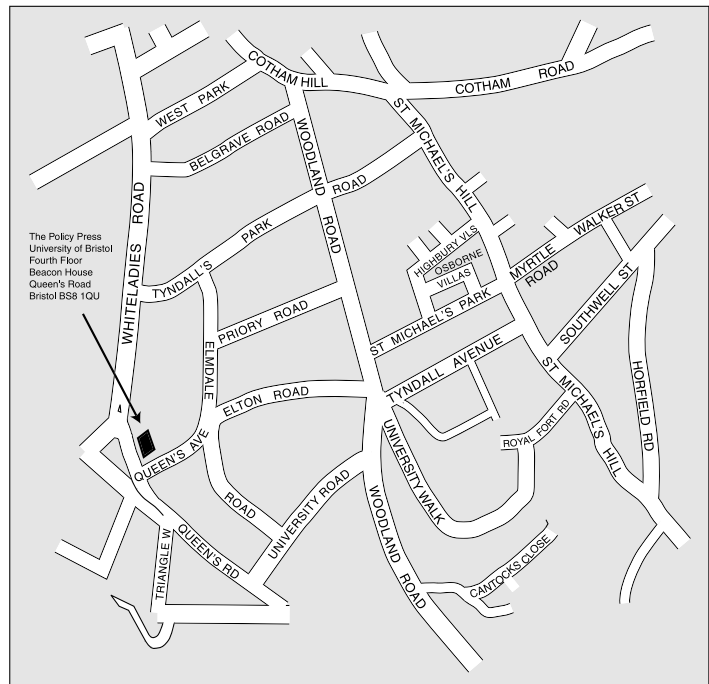

How to get here if you travel by rail

There are two stations in Bristol - Temple Meads and Parkway. If there is an option, we recommend you go to Temple Meads which is much closer and has bus services that go to the Clifton area of Bristol.



From Bristol Temple Meads station:

Temple Meads station is about 1.25 miles from The Policy Press.

The 8/9 circular bus service (renumbered to 508/509 at certain times of day) runs every 15 minutes or so from Temple Meads. The number 9 bus goes in the right direction for the trip (the number 8 goes in the opposite direction). There is a bus stop outside Habitat on Queen's Road.

There is also a taxi-rank at the station.

You can of course walk from the station, but be warned that the optimum route is not that easy to find and that we are situated at the top of a hill.

From Bristol Parkway station:

Parkway station is about 6 miles from the University. You are recommended to take a taxi.

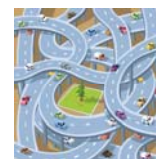
How to get here if you travel by coach

The coach station is on Marlborough Street (near the centre right of our map). There is a taxi-rank outside the station. To walk to The Policy Press (about 15-20 minutes) from the coach station walk along Marlborough street and Upper Maudlin Street on to Perry Road, then on to Park Row. Continue along Park Row until it meets Queen's Road by the Wills Building (University building with tower). Continue along Queen's Road on the same side as the Wills Building, go past Sainsbury's and you will soon reach Habitat.



How to get here if you travel by car

Firstly a word of warning: parking is very difficult near the University. If you let us know that you are coming by car we can try to book you a visitor's space in one of the University car parks (unauthorised cars are liable to be clamped). There are multi-story car parks about 5 minutes walk away and downhill relative to The Press.



Directions from M32:

- Exit the M4 at junction 19 marked for the M32. Follow the M32 into Bristol.
- Carry straight on from the end of the motorway. Keep in the right-hand lane (following the signs to Clifton).
- At St. James Barton roundabout take the second exit (following signs to the University of Bristol).
- Go straight on over several sets of traffic lights. Just after the entrance to the multistorey car park on your left, turn right into Woodland Road.

If you are parking in the visitor car park you will need to look out for The Hawthorns which is on the left hand corner of the junction of Woodland Road and Elton Road (second turning on the left as you drive up Woodland Road). If spaces are not available next to the road look for the gap in the building on the Woodland Road side, there are more spaces here at the back of the building.

After you have parked in The Hawthorns car park walk down Elton Road, on to Queen's Avenue and turn right on to Queen's Road. The Policy Press is in Beacon House – the main door is to the left of Habitat's main door.

If you want to travel by bike

There are bicycle racks outside The Policy Press if you need somewhere to lock your bike.



How to get here if you travel by air

From London Heathrow:

There is a direct National Express Coach Service between Heathrow and Bristol. Alternatively you can take the Heathrow Airport Express to London Paddington and a Great Western train from Paddington to Bristol. There is also a Railair link coach service which runs between Heathrow and Reading. Most Paddington to Bristol trains stop at Reading.



From Bristol International Airport:

The airport is about 8 miles to the south of Bristol centre. The Bristol International Flyer bus service operates between the airport and key destinations in Bristol. The 330 Flyer service stops at Clifton Triangle West (a five-minute walk from the University) and the 331 stops at Bristol Bus and Coach Station (a 20-minute walk from the University).

Taxis are also available from the airport.
