Submission of papers

Submissions should be sent to Caroline Paskell, Centre for Analysis of Social Exclusion, London School of Economics and Political Science, London, WC2A 2AE, c.a.paskell@lse.ac.uk. Please note that commissioned articles should be sent to the appropriate commissioning editor.

Authors are requested to email electronic copy as an attached file in Word. Articles should be anonymised, ready for sending to referees, and be accompanied by an email address or note giving full contact details of the author(s) and, in the case of jointly authored articles, nominating an author for correspondence.

Articles should be between 2,500 and 5,000 words (including references) in length. Longer or shorter articles may be accepted by arrangement with the editorial board. Authors should make clear the policy context, reference only directly relevant literature, adopt an intelligible structure and a lucid style, use rigorous argument and reach strong conclusions. Technical and statistical material is best omitted or presented as an appendix. An abstract of not more than 100 words should be included. All articles are refereed to assess their suitability for publication.
