

Single Site Licence Agreement between The Policy Press and users of the electronic versions of its journals.

The Policy Press (TPP) will licence the electronic access to journals published by The Policy Press on the terms and conditions set out in this Agreement. The rights granted under this Agreement apply only to those journals for which the Licensee has a current paid subscription, or to those documents that the Licensee has paid for by credit card.

1. Copyright

- (a) all copyright in the journals and the documents contained in the journals is owned by TPP and/or its respective licensors. All rights not expressly granted in this Agreement are reserved to the copyright owners.
- (b) Subject to the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988, the use of material supplied by TPP is limited to viewing, downloading, temporary storage and printing a single copy of the individual document by Authorized Users for personal use only.

2. Access

Online access to current and selected back issues is available:

- (a) to current subscribers of print and online or online only versions of the relevant journal.
- (b) To non-subscribers on payment of a fee to TPP through Ingenta's "Pay-per-View" service or other services licensed by The Policy Press

Rights granted under this Agreement cannot be transferred, sold, or rented to another party.

Where the Licensee is a single institution or organisation with a current paid subscription to the Journal(s) the Authorized Users are current members of staff of the Licensee (whether on a permanent or temporary contract or visiting basis and individuals who are currently studying at the Licensee's institution, who are permitted to access the institution's secure networks from within the library premises or from such other places where Authorized Users work or study (including but not limited to Authorized Users' offices and homes, halls of residence and student dormitories) and who have been issued by the Licensee with a password or other authentication, together with other persons who are permitted to use the Licensee's library or information service and access the secure network but only from computer terminals within the library premises.

Access to the full backfile of *Policy & Politics* is only available through premium rate subscriptions or outright purchase of the backfile.

N.B. Access under this agreement is granted to single institutions only. Academic and other consortia are specifically excluded from this Agreement and should contact The Policy Press separately.

Post-cancellation perpetual access for all Policy Press journals is granted to the content published during the subscription years that have been paid for.

3. Licensee's responsibilities

The Licensee is responsible for all charges associated with accessing the Journal(s) such as computer equipment and internet access.

4. Liability

- (a) TPP has taken reasonable care to ensure that data in the Journal(s) available through this service is error-free and up to date. However, TPP accepts no responsibility for corruption to the data including, but not limited to any defects caused by transmission of the data.
- (b) TPP is using a third-party service to provide electronic access to the Journal(s). TPP accepts no responsibility for any defect, failure or non-availability of the service.

5. Termination

- (a) TPP may terminate or suspend electronic access for breach of this licence by the institution or any user.
- (b) TPP may terminate electronic access if its agreement with the third-party service terminates for any reason. However, TPP will use reasonable endeavours to find an alternative third-party service.

6. General

This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales. Both parties agree to submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.

7. Acceptance

In downloading a document, I agree to abide by the terms of the Agreement. TPP reserves the right to vary this Agreement from time to time. Such changes shall be posted on the relevant web page. Changes made in this manner shall be deemed to have been accepted by users who download, store or print any document after a period of 14 days following the day the changes have been posted on this web page.
